High Water Designations

In West Virginia, High Water fleeting rates will go into effect when the South Side Bridge on the Kanawha River water level reaches 11'.

HIGH WATER - When the Baton Rouge gauge reaches 28' (High Water status) there will be a 33.3% surcharge on all rates on the LMR due to a reduction of tow sizes and fleeting capacity as per the Mississippi River Crisis Action Plan.

EXTREME HIGH WATER - When the Carrolton gauge reaches 12' (Extreme High Water) an **additional surcharge will be added to all In/Out charges for all LMR fleets, which is a result of the additional HP requirements as mandated by the USCG in 33 CFR § 165.803. **Extreme High Water Surcharge \$210
